Foyle's War, Series IV

The popular World War II whodunit hailed "a triumph from start to finish" by the *Wall Street Journal*, "one of the best mysteries you'll ever see on the telly," by the *San Francisco Chronicle*, and "a wonderful Brit confection" by *The Boston Globe* returns with four new 90-minute episodes. *Foyle's War*, Series IV airs Sundays, June 17 through July 8, 2007 at 9pm ET (check local listings.)

Set in the south coast of England, *Foyle's War* stars Michael Kitchen (*Reckless, Oliver Twist*) as the no-nonsense Detective Chief Superintendent Christopher Foyle, who fights his own battles on the home front while war rages over Europe. In Series IV, Foyle and his team clash with government orders while investigating a murder on an American Army base, uncover secret government research after a biological warfare experiment goes awry, investigate the murder of Sgt. Milner's estranged wife, and probe the secret world of weapons research after a local man is brutally murdered at a weapons research center.

"Invasion" - Sunday, June 17, 2007 at 9pm

When a young woman is found murdered on an American Army base after a secret affair with a young American soldier, Foyle (Michael Kitchen) receives a warning from the War Office to tread carefully. But his determination to find the truth about the girl's death forces him to break government orders: Did the American kill the unfaithful barmaid, or has he been framed?

"Bad Blood" - Sunday, June 24, 2007 at 9pm

A biological warfare experiment goes wrong, leaving a local woman dead and Sam (Honeysuckle Weeks) hospitalized, her body covered in black sores. With Sam's life in jeopardy, Foyle's search for answers takes him into the most secretive areas of the war: research even Churchill doesn't know about.

"Bleak Midwinter" - Sunday, July 1, 2007 at 9pm

A young woman is found dead at a munitions factory, and Foyle suspects her death is an industrial accident. But when another woman—Sergeant Milner's estranged wife, Jane—is brutally murdered in town, he begins to suspect that the two deaths are linked. When Sgt. Milner (Anthony Howell) emerges as the prime suspect, Foyle and Sam must step up the investigation to prove his innocence.

"Casualties of War" - Sunday, July 8, 2007 at 9pm

Searching for his missing god-daughter, Lydia, taking care of her son, and a series of sabotage cases are enough to keep Foyle very busy. To add to the pressure, his boss wants him to work on stamping out illegal gaming along the South Coast. But when a local gambler is found murdered near a military research center—the target of some internationally funded saboteurs—sabotage and gambling come together, and Foyle must enter the top-secret arena of weapons research in pursuit of the truth.

Foyle's War, Series IV is a Greenlit Productions production presented on PBS by WGBH Boston. It was written and created by Anthony Horowitz.
