Episode One

Sunday, September 11th at 10pm ET

Three years have passed since last season. Aafrin is secretly fighting for Indian independence from inside the civil service. Does Ralph suspect his disloyalty?

Episode Two

Sunday, September 18th at 10pm ET

Aafrin saves his friend's life but gets a gruesome payback. Ralph's ambition faces a roadblock. Sooni feels family pressure. And Madeline extracts the truth.

Episode Three

Sunday, September 25th at 10pm ET
