#### General description

The war in Europe is over, and Detective Chief Superintendent Christopher Foyle hopes his crime-fighting days are too. But murder knows no respite in the seaside town of Hastings, and the unflappable chief must solve a trio of his most challenging cases yet. Michael Kitchen stars with Honeysuckle Weeks in the hit series praised by *The Wall Street Journal* as “consistently captivating.”

#### Episode 1: The Russian House

**Sunday, May 2, 2010 at 9 to 10:30pm ET on PBS**

In the war's aftermath, Hastings is a transit point for Russian POWs who changed sides to fight for the Nazis and now face an uncertain future. The War Office assigns Foyle (Michael Kitchen) to track down one escapee, and the reason for his flight becomes shockingly clear.

#### Episode 2: Killing Time

**Sunday, May 9, 2010 at 9 to 10:30pm ET on PBS**

Black American GIs waiting to be shipped home from their camp near Hastings find themselves unwelcome by locals. Tensions are complicated by a mixed-race baby who lives with her English mother in a rooming house run by Foyle's (Michael Kitchen) former driver Sam (Honeysuckle Weeks) and her friend Adam (Max Brown). A brutal murder ensues, and Foyle must solve it.

#### Episode 3: The Hide

**Sunday, May 16, 2010 at 9 to 10:30pm ET on PBS**

Newly retired, Foyle (Michael Kitchen) is drawn to the case of a well-connected local man who is condemned to death for aiding the Nazis during the war. Foyle suspects the doomed man is concealing evidence that will exonerate him. Meanwhile, Sam (Honeysuckle Weeks) and Adam (Max Brown) fight for the survival of their rooming house—and discover they make a great team.
